Summary

This marine notice serves to inform of incorrect prescribed charges published in the latest Government Gazette 43573 dated 31 July 2020 – South African Maritime Safety Authority Act (5/1998): Determination of charges

The latest Determination of Charges are applicable effective 24 August 2020. These are formally published in Government Gazette 43573 dated 31 July 2020. The Determination of Charges Regulations, Regulation 70 (Variation and waiver of charges) allows for SAMSA to deviate from the set charges. The corrected charges as indicated below will be applicable in terms of Examinations & Certification for small vessel skippers.
